### **Valentines Day Recipe: Heart Shaped Eggs and Toast**

Give your sweetheart a fantastic start to Valentines Day with this fun and easy recipe courtesy of [www.marthastewart.com](http://www.marthastewart.com) Using a 3-inch heart-shaped cookie cutter, remove the center of a thick slice of bread, and toast it. Melt 1 ½ teaspoons butter in a small skillet over medium heat. Place bread slice in skillet, and cook until underside is lightly browned. Add 1 ½ teaspoons butter, and flip bread. Fit cookie cutter, coated with cooking spray in bread's cutout heart and crack an egg into cutter. Cover skillet, and cook until egg is set, 2 to 3 minutes. Use tongs to remove cutter. Serve with bacon and toasted heart for dipping into yolk.
