Just a Reminder

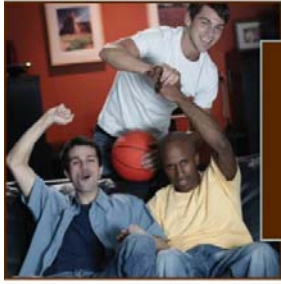
